The organisation's primary objectives are to build the capacity of the Aboriginal community and individuals of the region. The objective of Djaringo is to deliver culturally appropriate flexible delivery training methods to improve the capabilities of Indigenous students. Djaringo offer a range of nationally accredited courses for Indigenous and Non-Indigenous people and has an approved scope of courses (Annex A) for delivery which are culturally appropriate and provide supportive flexible delivery training methods.
