The organisation's primary objectives are to build the capacity of the Aboriginal community and individuals of the region. The objective of Djaringo is to deliver culturally appropriate flexible delivery improve trainina methods to the capabilities of Indigenous students. nationally Djaringo offer a range of accredited courses for Indigenous and Non-Indigenous people and has an approved scope of courses (Annex A) for delivery which are culturally appropriate and provide supportive flexible delivery training methods.
